8.	Performs safe and effective treatment appropriate to the patient's condition and age. <i>eg. manual techniques</i>		
9.	Performs effective suction technique in accordance with LHD/Network policy.		
10.	Re-assesses patient (sees 4. and 5. above) during and after treatment and able to adapt treatment if the need arises.		
11.	Demonstrates the ability to communicate effectively with staff/patients/families and to work collaboratively within a team.
