It aligns with the Zero Suicide Framework and components of NSW Health suicide care pathways: engage and identify, assessment, formulation, brief interventions, treatment and transitions of care.

- Module 3: Comprehensive assessment with a person experiencing suicidal distress
- Module 4: Suicide prevention formulation
- Module 5: Safety planning and counselling to reduce access to means
- Module 6: Comprehensive care planning and transitions of care
